Ideas for schools

Many schools benefit from a visit from a PAT Dog and see the joy a four-legged friend can bring. Walk this May is a great opportunity for classes and pupils to do something in return to help raise funds for Pets As Therapy so we can provide more visits and reach more schools.

We recognise the challenge of walking 100km over the month may not be achievable, but you can get involved by taking on another Walk this May challenge.

We're sure you'll have your own fundraising ideas as to how your school can Walk this May, but we wanted to share some of our suggestions.

- Walk 100km collectively as a school or a class.
- Pick one day for every child to walk 1km (or 1 mile) around the playing field or playground.
- Do it as a relay walk. One class can set off on a walking challenge then they can hand the baton on to the next class. This could be done on different days.
- Involve parents, the PTA and governors in a Walk this May challenge – perhaps your PAT Volunteer and their pet will be happy to walk with you.
- Change Walk this May to Walk this Day and encourage children to walk to school and home again (as long as they are safe and accompanied).
- Tweak the name to Bake this May and organise a cake sale alongside any walking challenge.
