

## **Pets As Therapy Family Subscriptions**

Pets As Therapy has introduced a Family Subscription to include the children/grandchildren of registered volunteers in the visiting scheme. Please see information regarding the subscription on this side and an application form on the reverse.

### Who does the family subscription include?

A **single** family subscription includes 1 **registered** volunteer and children or grandchildren belonging to that family.

A **joint** family subscription includes 2 **registered** volunteers and children or grandchildren belonging to that family.

### Cost

For a single family subscription, the annual cost is £25

For a joint family subscription, the annual cost is £35

The minimum age for children joining is 8yrs of age

The registered adult volunteer (over 18yrs of age) must be in control of the PAT dog or cat at all times.

For insurance purposes, once a child reaches 18 years of age, they will need to join Pets As Therapy as a full volunteer. Please contact the Registration Office at that time for details.

## Family Subscription

### **Guidance Notes**

### On Pets As Therapy official visits:

- 1. Registered volunteers must be the parents, guardians or grandparents of the children and must be at least 18yrs of age.
- 2. Please do telephone your establishment contact if you would like your children to visit with you, to ensure that this is acceptable to the establishment and is an appropriate place for children to visit. For example, some mental health establishments may not permit children to visit.
- 3. No more than 2 children may accompany the registered adult volunteer/s on any visit. These children must be registered with Pets As Therapy under the Family Subscription scheme and remain the responsibility of the registered adult volunteer/s at all times.
- 4. The minimum age for children joining is 8yrs old. Once they reach 18yrs of age, they are eligible to join the Charity as a visiting volunteer
- 5. The registered **adult** volunteer/s must remain in control of the PAT dog or cat at all times this means that they must have hold of the lead at all times.

## Representing Pets As Therapy at events:

If you are representing the Charity at a local event or show with your PAT dog or cat, the above guidelines will still apply with respect to any accompanying children. Please do familiarise yourselves with them in order to comply with the Charity's public liability insurance responsibilities.

Please do let any event organisers know that you intend to bring your children along with you and if you have a local Voluntary Area Co-ordinator, please also let them know if you are attending a local event with registered children.
